<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Core Function: Develop, implement and maintain a CFP for Koonwarra Village and its environs • Driver: Optimise the safety and well-being of people, assets (built and environment) and native species in the face of increasing bushfire risk • CFA role widely misunderstood - expectation that CFA has the responsibility for protecting the community versus individual responsibility with CFA providing resources, knowledge and support • Public apathy - <5% have Fire Plans - community is unprepared and at significant high risk • Demographics have changed - many older residents have left and new residents entered Koonwarra.
